## TOWN OF HANOVER JOINS GREY BRUCE HEALTH UNIT IN SEARCH OF VACCINE HUB VOLUNTEERS AS CLINICS RAMP UP

**HANOVER, ON -** Volunteers are vital to the operation of Hanover's P & H Centre Hockey Hub Vaccine Clinic. Public Health has advised that they will be receiving a significant quantity of vaccines resulting in the vaccination hub operating large clinics several times per week during July. Many volunteers will be required to support the vital role Hanover is playing in the efforts to bring this pandemic under control in Grey and Bruce County.

Volunteers are required for various roles inside and outside of the P&H Centre. Outside, at least 10 volunteers are needed at any one time to assist with parking and directing clients. Inside, 20 - 25 volunteers are needed throughout the day to assist with cleaning, navigating and screening clients.
