

HANOVER PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD

The Hanover Public Library Board is appointed by Council under the authority granted by the Province of Ontario in the *Public Libraries Act* for the purpose of managing library affairs. The library board does not run the library, but ensures that it is properly run.

The Library Board establishes policies, oversees the finances, sets fees for non-residents, determines library mission and goals, and hires the CEO. The Board submits budget estimates and financial statements to municipal council and must report statistics and finances to the province annually to receive its grant.

COMPOSITION

- 9 members who shall be appointed by Council from time to time
- 1 member appointed from the members of Council
- 8 members of the public being appointed for the term of the Council
- the members shall annually or at their discretion select a chair from amongst their members

MEETING SCHEDULE

The Hanover Public Library Board holds 10 meetings per year, typically the fourth Thursday of each month.
