## CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HANOVER

### BY -LAW 3068–19, as amended by By-law 3187-21 and By-law 3247-22

BEING a By-law to Regulate and/or Control the Parking, Stopping and Standing of Vehicles in the Town of Hanover.

---

**WHEREAS** Section 11, of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001 c.25 and the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990 H.8*, as amended authorize a Municipal Council to pass by-laws to regulate and control traffic;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 425 of the *Municipal Act* permits a municipality to pass bylaws providing that a person who contravenes a by-law of the municipality passed under this Act is guilty of an offence;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 100 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended confer upon a local municipality may, in respect of land not owned or occupied by the municipality that is used as a parking lot, regulate or prohibit the parking or leaving of motor vehicles on that land without the consent of the owner of the land or regulate or prohibit traffic on that land if a sign is erected at each entrance to the land clearly indicating the regulation or prohibition;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Fire Prevention & Protection Act, 1997*, Chapter 4, Section 7.1 (c), provides that a municipality may pass by-laws designating private roads as fire routes along which no parking of vehicles shall be permitted and providing for the removal and impounding of any vehicle parked or left along any of the fire routes at the expense of the owner of the vehicle;

**AND WHEREAS** Sections 63 and 101 of the *Municipal Act* permit such by-law to authorize the impounding of vehicles improperly parked;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 170(15) of the *Highway Traffic Act* states that "A police officer, police cadet, municipal law enforcement officer or an officer appointed for carrying out the provisions of this Act, upon discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of subsection (12), of a regulation made under subsection 26(3) of the *Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act* or a municipal bylaw, may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for the removal, care and storage of the vehicle, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the *Repair and Storage Liens Act, 2005*, c.26, Schedule. A, s.28 (2);

**AND WHEREAS** Section 427, of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001 c.25, "A by-law establishing a system of Accessible parking shall provide that every person who contravenes the By-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not less than \$300.00";

**AND WHEREAS** The *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005*, S.O. 2005, c. 11 ("AODA, 2005") specifies mandatory accessibility standards with the goal of identifying, removing and preventing barriers for people with disabilities in key areas of daily living;

**AND WHEREAS** Accessible Parking Spaces are regulated by Part IV.1 - Design of Public Spaces Standards, of Ontario Regulation 191/11 - Integrated Accessibility Standards (Ontario Regulation 191/11) made under the AODA, 2005;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 102 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, confers upon municipalities the power to pass by-laws for requiring the owners and operators of parking lots or other parking facilities to which the public has access, to provide designated parking spaces for the sole use of vehicles displaying an accessible parking permit issued and displayed in accordance with the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8*, as amended and the regulations made under it, and for prescribing the conditions of use of such permit and for prohibiting the improper use of the permit;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hanover deems it expedient to pass a by-law to regulate and control parking within the Town of Hanover;

**NOW THEREFORE** he Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hanover hereby enacts as follows:

This by-law may be cited as the "Parking By-law".

**1. DEFINITIONS** for the purpose of this bylaw:

- 1.1 "Authorized emergency vehicle"** means,
- i) a Fire Department vehicle, including an emergency crash extrication vehicle, while proceeding to a fire or emergency call or responding to, but not returning from, a fire alarm or other emergency call;
  - ii) a vehicle while used by a person in the lawful performance of their duties as a police officer;
  - iii) an ambulance or cardiac arrest emergency vehicle while responding to an emergency call or being used to transport a patient or injured person in an emergency situation, or
  - iv) an emergency vehicle of a public or private utility, or Federal, Provincial or Municipal Department when such a vehicle is being used in the performance of emergency duties;
- 1.2 "Authorized sign"** means any sign or roadway, curb or sidewalk marking or device placed or erected under the authority of the Town of Hanover, County of Grey, or Province of Ontario, for the purpose of regulating or controlling traffic and includes official signs;
- 1.3 "Bicycle"** includes a bicycle, tricycle, a unicycle and a power-assisted e-bicycle but does not include a motor-assisted bicycle;
- 1.4 "Boulevard"** means that part of the highway between the roadway and the property lines of the lots abutting the highway and includes the shoulder but does not include a sidewalk, if any;
- 1.5 "Bus stop"** means that portion of a highway, designated by an authorized sign, for the use of buses as a point for loading and unloading passengers and including an area sufficient to accommodate the length of the bus;
- 1.6 "Chief Fire Official"** means the Fire Chief of the Corporation of the Town of Hanover or their designate;
- 1.7 "Chief of Police"** means the Chief of the Hanover Police Service or their designate;
- 1.8 "Commercial motor vehicle"** means a motor vehicle with a permanently attached truck or delivery body and includes an ambulance, hearse, casket wagon, fire apparatus, buses and tractors used for hauling purposes on the highways;
- 1.9 "Corner"** means the point of intersection of curbs or edges of the highway used for vehicular traffic;
- 1.10 "Council"** means the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hanover;
- 1.11 "Crosswalk"** means:
- i) that part of the highway at an intersection that is included within the connections of the lateral lines of the sidewalks on opposite sides of the highway measured from the curbs, or in the absence of curbs, the edges of the travelled portion of the highway, or;
  - ii) any portion of a roadway at an intersection or elsewhere distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs, lines or other markings on the road surface;
- 1.12 "Curb"** means the edge of a travelled portion of the roadway;
- 1.13 "Delivery Vehicle"** means a vehicle used by a company or individual for the exclusive purpose of delivery and or taking away of merchandise;
- 1.14 "Designated accessible parking space"** means a parking space approved for the exclusive use of a vehicle displaying a current and valid Accessible Parking Permit, in a public parking lot owned by the Town or being on private property or on a highway under the jurisdiction of the Town;
- 1.15 "Disabled person"** means an individual that meets the requirements of such as set out in the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005, S.O. 2005, c. 11*;

- 1.16 "Driver"** means a person who drives a vehicle on a highway;
- 1.17 "Drop Off Zone"** means a space, zone or portion of a highway adjacent to a curb designated by an authorized sign permitting stopping of a vehicle therein while under continuous supervision of the driver, and only for the period necessary while actively engaged in loading or unloading passengers;
- 1.18 "Enforcement Officer"** means:
- i) a Provincial Offences Officer and/or Police Officer for the Town of Hanover; or
  - ii) a person appointed by Council to enforce or carry out the provisions of this By-law, or any part or parts thereof, who is by virtue of their appointment a Provincial Offences Officer when enforcing the provision or provisions of this By-law;
- 1.19 "Fire Route"** means any access route, public or private roadway, lane, ramp or other means of vehicular access being 5 metres in width into or egress from a building or structure, and designated as a fire route and shall include part of a parking lot set aside for use by authorized emergency vehicles unless otherwise authorized by the Chief Fire Official and designated by visible markings or markers as a fire route;
- 1.20 "Fire Route Sign"**, means a permanently installed legible sign having a minimum size of 30 cm by 45 cm (12" by 18"), placed at intervals of not more than 20 metres (65 feet) along the route, and be placed at each end of the fire route, and shall display the following information by text or symbol:
- a) Fire Route
  - b) No Parking or Parking Prohibited
- 1.21 "Gross weight"** means the combined weight of a vehicle and its load;
- 1.22 "Heavy Truck"** means a commercial motor vehicle having a weight when unloaded of 3 tonnes (3,000 kilograms) or more, or when loaded of 5 tonnes (5,000 kilograms) or more, but does not include a passenger vehicle, an ambulance, or any vehicle of the Police or Fire Departments;
- 1.23 "Highway or Street"** includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, public lane, parkway, alley, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, and any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lines thereof;
- 1.24 "Holiday"** means holidays outlined in the Retail Business Holidays Act
- 1.25 "Intersection"** means the area embraced within the prolongation or connection of the lateral lines, curb lines, or if none, then of the lateral boundary lines of two or more roadways that join one another at an angle, whether or not one roadway crosses the other;
- 1.26 "Median"** means a portion of a highway so constructed as to separate traffic traveling in one direction from traffic traveling in the opposite direction by a physical barrier or an unpaved strip of ground;
- 1.27 "Minister"** means the Minister of Transportation;
- 1.28 "Ministry"** means the Ministry of Transportation;
- 1.29 "Motor assisted Bicycle"** means a bicycle:
- i) that is fitted with pedals that are operable at all times to propel the bicycle;
  - ii) that weighs not more than fifty-five kilograms;
  - iii) that has no hand or foot operated clutch or gearbox driven by the motor and transferring power to the driven wheel;
  - iv) that has an attached motor driven by electricity or having a piston displacement of not more than fifty cubic centimetres; and
  - v) that does not have sufficient power to enable the bicycle to attain a speed greater than 50 kilometres per hour on level ground within a distance of 2 kilometres from a standing start;
- 1.30 "Motor vehicle"** includes an automobile, a motorcycle, a motor-assisted bicycle unless otherwise indicated in this Act, and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power, but does not include a street car or other motor vehicle running only upon rails, a power-assisted bicycle, a

motorized snow vehicle, a traction engine, a farm tractor, a self-propelled implement of husbandry or a road-building machine;

- 1.31 "Multi-Use Trail"** means that part of a highway with its surface improved with asphalt, concrete or gravel for the use of pedestrians and non-motorized vehicles;
- 1.32 "Municipality"** means the Corporation of the Town of Hanover;
- 1.33 "Municipal or Public Property"** means property that is dedicated to public use;
- 1.34 "Municipal vehicles"** includes but is not limited to vehicles owned by the Town and/or contractors having a valid contract with the Town to supply municipal services. These services may include road building, road maintenance, emergency services, garbage collection, recycling, hydro, water, etc.;
- 1.35 "Official Sign"** means a sign approved by the Ministry of Transportation;
- 1.36 "Occupant"** means:
- i) the tenant of the property or part thereof whose consent shall extend only to the control of the land of which he is the tenant and any parking spaces allotted to him under the lease or tenancy agreement; or,
  - ii) the spouse of a tenant; or,
  - iii) a person authorized, in writing by an occupant as defined in subsection (i) or (ii) to act on the occupant's behalf for requesting the enforcement of this section.
- 1.37 "Off Street Parking"** refers to parking lots or other parking facilities to which the general public has access, whether on payment of a fee or otherwise;
- 1.38 "On Street Parking"** refers to parking on any highway or road or part thereof in the Corporation;
- 1.39 "One-way street"** means a street upon which vehicular traffic is limited to movement in one direction only;
- 1.40 "Owner"** when used in relation to property means:
- i) the registered owner of the property or the spouse of that person; or,
  - ii) a person authorized, in writing by the property owner as defined in subsection (i) to act on behalf of the owner in requesting the enforcement of this section;
  - iii) where the property is included in a description registered under the *Condominium Act*, the Board of Directors of the Condominium Corporation;
- 1.41 "Park or Parking"** when prohibited, means the standing of a vehicle whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers;
- 1.42 "Parking Infraction Notice"** means a Notice authorized by the *Provincial Offences Act* and handed to the driver or placed on any vehicle parked in contravention of this By-law;
- 1.43 "Parking Space"** means an area that has been designated and marked for the temporary parking of motor vehicles;
- 1.44 "Pedestrian"** includes a person on foot, in a wheelchair and a child in a wheeled carriage;
- 1.45 "Pedestrian crossover"** means any portion of a roadway, designated by By-law of a Municipality, at an intersection or elsewhere, distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs on the highway and lines or other markings on the surface of the roadway as prescribed by the regulations under the *Highway Traffic Act*;
- 1.46 "Permit"** means a current and valid Disabled Person Parking Permit issued by the Ministry pursuant to the *Highway Traffic Act* and the regulations made thereunder or a Permit, numbered plate or other marker or device issued by another jurisdiction and recognized under that Act;
- 1.47 "Police Officer"** means a member of the Hanover Police Service or a person authorized by the Chief of Police to regulate or direct traffic;
- 1.48 "Private property"** means any property within the Town not owned by or occupied by the Town;

- 1.49 **"Private road"** means any road, lane, ramp or other means of vehicular access to or from a building or structure that is not owned by the Town, County of Grey or Province of Ontario and may include part of a parking lot;
- 1.50 **"Provincial Offences Officer"** means a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, Police Officer, or persons designated by Municipal Council for the purposes of enforcing all or any class of offences;
- 1.51 **"Public Park"** means any public area used for park purposes which is owned or leased by the Town;
- 1.52 **"Public parking lot"** means any open public area or portion of a structure other than a street or highway, intended for the temporary parking of vehicles and on which there are designated parking spaces, whether their use involves the payment of a fee or otherwise, which is owned by or leased by the Town;
- 1.53 **"Regulations"** means regulations made under the *Highway Traffic Act*, *Provincial Offences Act*, or other applicable Provincial legislation;
- 1.54 **"Roadway"** means that portion of a highway that is improved, designed or ordinarily used for the passage of vehicles, but does not include the shoulder and where a highway includes two or more separate roadways the term "roadway" refers to any one roadway separately and not all of the roadways collectively;
- 1.55 **"School Day"** means a day that is within a school year and is not a holiday, as determined by the Education Act;
- 1.56 **"Sidewalk"** means that portion of a highway between the curb line or lateral lines of a roadway and the adjacent property line that is designed and intended for the use of pedestrians;
- 1.57 **"Stall"** means a space marked off for the parking of motor vehicles;
- 1.58 **"Stand or Standing"** when permitted means the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging of passengers;
- 1.59 **"Stop"**, when required, means a complete cessation of movement;
- 1.60 **"Stop or Stopping"** when prohibited means the halting of a vehicle momentarily, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or a traffic control sign or signal;
- 1.61 **"Time"** where any expression of time occurs or where any hour or other period of time is stated, the time referred to shall be Eastern Standard Time, except during a period when daylight saving time is in effect in the Town of Hanover, when the time referred to shall be one hour in advance of standard time;
- 1.62 **"Town"** means the Corporation of the Town of Hanover;
- 1.63 **"Traffic"** includes pedestrians, ridden or herded animals, vehicles and any other conveyances either singly or together, while using any highway for the purpose of travel;
- 1.64 **"Traffic control device"** means any device, manually, electrically or mechanically operated for the regulation of traffic;
- 1.65 **"Travel trailer"** means a structure designed, intended and used exclusively for travel, recreation and vacation and which is capable to being drawn or propelled by a motor vehicle or is propelled and includes tent trailers or similar transportable accommodations excepting mobile homes;
- 1.66 **"Trailer"** means a vehicle that is at any time drawn upon a highway by a motor vehicle;
- 1.67 **"Vehicle"** includes a motor vehicle, motor assisted bicycle, trailer, motorcycle, travel trailer, boat trailer, motorized snow vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, bus, road-building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power;
- 1.68 **"Wheelchair"** means a chair mounted on wheels driven by muscular or any kind of power, this includes motorized scooters and other personal mobility devices used for the carriage of a person with a disability;

- 1.69 **"Words"** where any word or expression used in this By-law is not defined herein reference shall be made to the *Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8.*, the *Municipal Act R.S.O. 2001*, as amended or re-enacted from time to time or generally accepted dictionary and the interpretation that best reflects the spirit and intent of this By-law shall be accepted.
- 1.70 **"Electric Vehicle"** means a vehicle that is propelled by one or more electric motors, using electrical energy stored in one or more rechargeable batteries or another energy storage device and is capable of being plugged into an Electric Vehicle Charging Station and includes a plug-in electric car and a plug-in hybrid car;
- 1.71 **"Electric Vehicle Charging Station"** means any facility or equipment that is used to charge a battery or other energy storage device of an Electric Vehicle;
- 1.72 **"Electric Vehicle Parking Space"** means a parking space designated for the use of Electric Vehicles as indicated by a sign in the form set out in Schedule "N-1" to this By-law.

The provisions of this By-law are subject to the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8.*, as amended or re-enacted from time to time, and the regulations made thereunder.

**2. APPLICATION AND ENFORCEMENT**

- 2.1 This By-law applies to all Highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Hanover, and Municipal and Private Property in so far as it applies to parking regulations.
- 2.2 The Director of Public Works or their designate is authorized to place or erect and maintain such Authorized Signs and traffic control signals as are required to give effect to the provisions of this By-law.
- 2.3 All measurements of distance relative to an intersection shall, where possible, be taken to or from a point where the prolongation or connection of the lateral curb lines meet on the side of the highway relative to said measurement.
- 2.4 The provisions of this By-law will be enforced by an Enforcement Officer.

**3. PARKING AND OPERATION OF VEHICLES**

- 3.1 Where authorized signs or markings have been erected or are on display, no person shall park a vehicle in non-compliance to the direction given by the said sign or markings as follows:
  - a) on any section of any street or property in the ownership of the Town when authorized signs have been approved and are on display prohibiting parking;
  - b) on any section of any street or property in the ownership of the Town when authorized signs have been approved and are on display, a time limit on parking.
- 3.2 Where parking spaces have been established by suitable markings on the road surface, no person shall park a vehicle except within the space designated by markings.
- 3.3 Where parking is permitted, no person shall park a vehicle on any highway, except on a one-way street or where angle parking is permitted, except on the right side of the highway having regard to the direction in which the vehicle had been proceeding and unless the right front and the right rear wheels of the vehicle are parallel to and distant respectively not more than 15 centimeters from the curb or edge of the roadway.
- 3.4 Notwithstanding the other provisions of this By-law, no person shall park a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to
  - a) interfere with the movement of traffic or:
  - b) the clearing of snow from the highway.

**4. BICYCLES**

- 4.1 No person shall park a bicycle on any boulevard or sidewalk except in an upright position and in a manner as not to impede the intended use of the boulevard or sidewalk.

**5. ANGLE PARKING**

- 5.1 No person shall angle park except where permitted and authorized signs are erected and on display, in those areas designated in Schedule "A" attached

to and forming part of this By-law on the highways described in Column 1, on the side or sides set forth in Column 2 opposite thereto within the boundaries set out in Column 3 opposite thereto respectively.

**6. ONE-WAY STREETS**

**6.1** Where parking is permitted on both sides of a one-way street, in addition to the provision of Section 10.1, a person shall park a vehicle facing only in the direction allowed on the lane with the left front and left rear wheels of the vehicle parallel to and distant respectively not more than 15 centimeters from the curb or edge of the roadway. This mode of parking also applies where parking is only allowed on the left side of a one-way street.

**7. PARKING PROHIBITED - SIGNAGE REQUIRED**

**7.1** Where Authorized Signs erected are on display, no person shall park a vehicle on the highways or part of highways set forth in Column 1 of Schedule "B" attached to and forming part of this By-law, on the side or sides set forth in Column 2 opposite thereto within the boundaries set out in Column 3 opposite thereto respectively.

**7.2** Where authorized signs are erected or are on display, no person shall park a vehicle on the highways or parts of the highways, on the side(s) and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedules "C, D, E and F" attached to and forming part of this By-law during the prohibited times or days set out in Column 4 of the said Schedules "C, D, E and F".

**7.3** **Where authorized signs are erected or are on display, no person shall park or stop a motor vehicle on any section of any street or property in the ownership of the Town for more than fifteen minutes as set out in Schedule "E-1" of this By-law.**

**7.4** **No person shall park a vehicle when authorized signs have been approved and are on display as set out in Schedule "G-1" of this Bylaw as follows:**

- (a) No person shall park a vehicle or any part of a vehicle in an Electric Vehicle Parking Space where such vehicle is not an Electric Vehicle.**
- (b) No person shall park a vehicle or any part of a vehicle in an Electric Vehicle Parking Space where such vehicle is not connected to an Electric Vehicle Charging Station and actively charging.**

**8. PARKING PROHIBITED- SIGNAGE NOT REQUIRED**

**8.1** No person shall park a vehicle:

- a) on or over a sidewalk or footpath;
- b) within an intersection;
- c) on or within 9 meters of a crosswalk or pedestrian crossover;
- d) within 9 meters of any intersection. Additional distance may be required at certain intersections and parking would be prohibited from the location of a sign reading "No Parking Here to Corner" to the intersection;
- e) on a median strip or on any boulevard (unless otherwise posted);
- f) on a bridge or approaches thereto;
- g) on a highway within 3 meters of a point or edge of the roadway nearest a fire hydrant;
- h) in such a position as to interfere with the removal of any vehicle previously parked or standing;
- i) in front of the entrance or exit to a lot or building where a fire department vehicle, public utility emergency vehicle, police vehicle or other emergency vehicle is kept stored, in such a manner as to impede the movement of such vehicles when responding to an emergency;
- j) at a public or private driveway in such a manner as to impede ingress and egress, or impair visibility of driveways as it intersects with the highway;
- k) on a highway for the purpose of displaying the vehicle for sale;
- l) on a highway for the purpose of washing, greasing or repairing the vehicle except for emergency repairs required to remove the vehicle;
- m) on the roadway when it is practicable to park the vehicle off the roadway;

- n) in a public park between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 am;
- o) on any highway between the hours of 1:00 am and 6:00 am commencing December 1st of each year and ending on March 31st the following year;
- p) in such a position so as to interfere with the removal of snow from any highway, sidewalk or parking lot in the Municipality;
- q) on any roadway prohibiting its use for parking until snow thereon is removed;
- r) in a place as to interfere with the formation of a funeral procession;
- s) no person shall park on municipal property without valid vehicle “**plate renewal**” or registration with the Ministry of Transportation;
- t) no person shall park on municipal property without current insurance coverage;
- u) in front of the main entrance to, or any emergency exit, from a theatre, auditorium, or other building while large assemblages are being held in such theatre, auditorium, or other building, or for a reasonable time immediately preceding and following such assemblages;
- v) in front of the entrance to a hotel, and any place designated as a loading zone where goods or merchandise are regularly delivered or removed;
- w) in front of the entrance to any hospital;
- x) on any roadway for an unreasonable time having regard for the traffic requirements of such roadway and in no case for a longer period of time than three (3) hours between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 am;
- y) alongside any curb upon which yellow paint has been applied;
- z) a motor vehicle on 10th Street between 4th Avenue and 15th Avenue for a longer period of time than is necessary for taking on or discharging its load;
  - i) on 10th Street from 6th Avenue to 13th Avenue where parking is permitted in no case for a longer period than two (2) hours between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday. Sundays and holidays are permitted;
  - ii) on 9th Avenue from 10th Street to 12th Street where parking is permitted in no case for a longer period than two (2) hours between the hours of 9:00 am and 6:00 pm Monday to Saturday. Sundays and holidays are permitted;
  - iii) on 10th Avenue from 10th Street to 12th Street where parking is permitted in no case for a longer period than two (2) hours between the hours of 9:00 am and 6:00 pm Monday to Saturday. Sundays and holidays are permitted;
- aa) no person shall park:
  - i) any tractor or trailer or combination of both;
  - ii) any truck having a weight when unloaded of 3 tonnes (3,000 kilograms) or more, or when loaded of 5 tonnes (5,000 kilograms) or more;
  - iii) any passenger or school bus designated for more than twenty-four (24) passengers;
    - on any roadway, more than two consecutive hours;
- bb) on any roadway having an overall width of more than six (6) meters;
- cc) in such a manner as to obstruct traffic.

**9. IN SPECIFIED PLACES WHERE SIGNS ARE ON DISPLAY - ANYTIME**

**9.1** Where properly worded signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall park any vehicle.

**10. IN SPECIFIED PLACES WHERE SIGNS ARE ON DISPLAY – SPECIFIED TIME**

**10.1** Where properly worded signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall park a vehicle on the highway or parts of highways.

**11. HEAVY TRUCKS**

**11.1** Where properly worded signs have been erected and are on display no person shall park a heavy truck on the highway or parts of highways.

**11.2** This section shall not apply to any vehicle actually engaged in making a delivery to or a collection from premises which cannot be reached except by way of a highway or to prohibit the use of such vehicle for such purpose provided that in making such delivery or collection the said highway or part of highway is traveled only insofar as is unavoidable in getting to or from such premises.

**12. PROHIBIT CERTAIN TRUCKS ON STREETS**

**12.1** When appropriate or authorized signs are erected and are on display, no person shall move, drive or operate a heavy truck on any highway or parts of highways within the Town of Hanover. This restriction shall not apply to any vehicle actually engaged in making a delivery to or a collection from premises which cannot be reached except by way of a highway or to prohibit the use of such vehicle for such purpose provided that in making such delivery or collection the said highway or portion of the highway is traveled only insofar as is unavoidable in getting to or from such premises.

**13. FUNERAL AND OTHER PROCESSIONS**

**13.1** Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any by-law of this Council prohibited parking on any highway or portions thereof, no such prohibition shall apply to vehicles parked on a highway in front of a funeral director's establishment during the period of 1-1/2 hours next preceding a funeral procession where the funeral director has caused signs to be placed on or adjacent to the highway indicating that a funeral is about to take place.

No person shall intersect a funeral or other properly authorized procession while it is in motion except under the direction of a police officer. The driver of a vehicle in a funeral or other procession shall drive as near to the right hand edge of the roadway as practicable and follow the vehicle ahead as close as is practicably and safe.

**14. EMERGENCY NO PARKING**

**14.1** Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any by-law of this Council respecting parking on any highway or street or portions thereof, no person shall park in any place where signs prohibiting parking have been placed on display under the direction of the Chief of Police for the purpose of snow removal, street cleaning, weddings, special events or other emergency provided, however, that said signs shall not become effective until two hours have elapsed after said signs have been so placed.

**15. CLOSED HIGHWAYS**

**15.1** No person shall drive a vehicle, except an emergency vehicle or a vehicle authorized by the Director of Public Works, or their designate, or by a police officer, on any highway that is roped, barricaded or marked by an authorized sign prohibiting its use.

**16. UNLICENSED VEHICLES**

**16.1** No person shall park a motor vehicle on a highway unless such motor vehicle has evidence of a currently validated **"plate renewal"** or permit displayed in accordance with the requirements of the Highway Traffic Act;

**17. ABANDONED VEHICLES**

**17.1** Notwithstanding any other provisions of this By-law, no person shall park, stand, or stop a vehicle on a highway or any other property owned or occupied by the Town for a period exceeding 72 hours, it shall be deemed to be abandoned, and upon complaint or discovery by an Enforcement Officer, may cause it to be moved to, or stored in a suitable place. All costs or charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle which may be enforced in a manner provided by the relevant provisions of the *Repair and Storage Liens Act*

**18. STOPPING PROHIBITED**

**18.1** No person shall stop a vehicle in any of the following areas, unless otherwise posted:

- a) on or over a sidewalk;
- b) on or within a crosswalk or pedestrian crossover;
- c) beside another stopped or parked vehicle;

- d) on a highway within 3 meters of a point on the curb or edge of the roadway directly opposite a fire hydrant;
- e) within a school bus loading zone, excepting school buses;
- f) in any area designated for accessible parking only, unless the vehicle is identified with an accessible parking permit prominently displayed on the dash or sun visor;
- g) in a Fire Route.

**19. PARKING-PRIVATE PROPERTY**

**19.1** No person shall park a motor vehicle:

- a) on private property without the consent of the owner or occupant of the property; or
- b) on property owned or occupied by the municipality or any local board thereof without the consent of the municipality or local board, as the case may be.

**19.2** In addition to any other penalty that may be imposed, any vehicle parked in contravention of this section shall be removed and impounded at the owner's expense and all costs become a lien against the motor vehicle.

**19.3** The driver or owner of a motor vehicle parked on private property is not liable to a penalty to have the motor vehicle removed from such property or impounded under this section except upon written complaint of the owner or occupant of the property given to the Enforcement Officer appointed to carry out the provisions of this By-law.

**19.4** Where an owner or occupant of property affected by this section has posted signs stating conditions on which motor vehicles may be parked on the property, or prohibiting the parking of a motor vehicle on the property, a motor vehicle parked on the property contrary to such conditions or prohibition shall be deemed to have been parked without consent.

**20. ACCESSIBLE PARKING**

**20.1** The location of designated accessible parking spaces, to which this By-law applies, are described in Schedule "H" attached to and forming a part of this Bylaw.

**20.2** When designated accessible parking spaces have been provided at locations described in Schedule "H" and Authorized Signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall park a vehicle in a designated accessible parking space except when the parking is for the convenience of a person with a disability and the vehicle displays a valid Accessible Parking Permit.

**20.3** In addition to the designated accessible parking spaces provided by the municipality, the owner or operator of a parking lot or other parking facility to which the public have access shall provide designated accessible parking spaces. The designated accessible parking spaces shall be in accordance with the applicable Zoning By-law and shall include the following for each accessible parking space:

- a) parking stall markings as per Schedule "H" attached to and forming part of this By-law.
- b) an accessible parking space sign as per Schedule "M" attached to and forming part of this By-law.

**20.4** Designated accessible parking signage in contravention of Schedule "H" may remain in effect if existed as of the date of the passage of this Bylaw.

**20.5** In addition to any other penalty that may be imposed, any vehicle parked in contravention of this section may be removed and impounded at the owner's expense and all costs incurred become a lien against the motor vehicle.

**20.6** In addition to the designated accessible parking spaces provided by the municipality, persons or organizations hosting special events shall provide designated accessible parking for people with disabilities.

**20.7** Authorized Signs and parking stall markings for spaces for use by a person with a disability shall be in the form and content as set out in Schedule "H" attached to and forming part of this By-law.

**21. FIRE ROUTES**

**21.1** Designated Fire Routes are described under Schedule "L" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.

- 21.2** Where a private roadway or parking lot, or part thereof has been established as a fire route under the *Fire Code* and approved by the Chief Fire Official, it is hereby designated as a fire route.
- 21.3** Each and every designated fire route shall be distinctly indicated by a sign, which is in a form and content as prescribed by the Chief Fire Official or their designate.
- 21.4** No person shall park at any time in a Fire Route.
- 22. DROP-OFF ZONES**
- 22.1** No person shall park a vehicle in any area designated by authorized posted signs as a drop-off zone.
- 23. EXCEPTIONS**
- 23.1** The provisions in this By-law shall not apply to any vehicle owned or operated by the Town, ambulances, military, police or fire department vehicles, vehicles owned by other public authorities and any other vehicle while actually engaged in performing works for the Town.
- 24. EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS**
- 24.1** Notwithstanding any other provisions of this By-law, the Chief of Police and/or the Chief Fire Official and/or Chief Emergency Management Coordinator, during an emergency or special circumstances, may declare a period of emergency parking prohibition and by use of appropriate signs or other clear directions may suspend parking of vehicles on any streets or portions thereof.
- 24.2** A vehicle parked previously to the declaration of the Chief of Police and/or the Chief Fire Official and/or Chief Emergency Management Coordinator, may be deemed to be parked in contravention of this section providing the owner or operator of the vehicle has been personally notified of the emergency parking prohibition and has been allowed a reasonable period of time to remove the vehicle. Any person who fails or refuses to obey the direction of the Chief of Police and/or the Chief Fire Official and/or Chief Emergency Management Coordinator shall commit a violation of this By-law.
- 24.3** No person shall park a vehicle during a declared emergency parking prohibition.
- 25. PENALTY PROVISIONS**
- 25.1** This By-law shall be enforced by Enforcement Officer(s) who enforce the provisions of this By-law.
- 25.2** In addition to any other penalty that may be imposed under this By-law, where a vehicle is parked in violation of any provisions of this By-law an Enforcement Officer may cause the vehicle to be taken and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, caring and storage thereof are a lien against the vehicle which may be enforced under the provisions of the *Repair and Storage Liens Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter R, 25*The owner of a vehicle found parked in violation of this By-law may be charged and convicted of an offence for which the driver of the vehicle is subject to charge, unless, at the time of the offence, the vehicle was in the possession of some person other than the owner without the owner's consent and on conviction the owner is liable to the penalties prescribed for the offence.
- 25.3** No liability for any such damage shall attach to the municipality or the operator or owner of any vehicle used to move a vehicle parked or standing in such a manner as to interfere with traffic or with the clearing of snow from the highway as aforesaid.
- 25.4** The owner of a vehicle found parked in violation of this By-law may be charged and convicted of an offence for which the driver of the vehicle has been charged.
- 25.5** An Enforcement Officer who finds a vehicle parked in violation of any provision of this By-law shall serve the owner or driver of the vehicle with a Parking Infraction Notice indicating:
- a) the license plate number of the vehicle;
  - b) that the vehicle was unlawfully parked;
  - c) the date, time and place of the alleged infraction;

- d) that the owner or driver of the vehicle may attend or send payment of the "Set Fine" to a location specified on the Notice;
  - e) that the failure to make payment of the "Set Fine" will result in further enforcement action.
- 25.6** The issuing Enforcement Officer shall serve the Parking Infraction Notice on the owner of the vehicle by affixing the Notice to the vehicle in a conspicuous place at the time of the alleged offence or by delivering the Notice personally to the person having care and control of the vehicle
- 25.7** A person receiving a Parking Infraction Notice shall pay the "Set Fine" indicated at the location on the Notice.
- 25.8** The terms and procedures in this section are pursuant to Part II of the *Provincial Offences Act* and for clarification or particularity reference should be made to the provisions of that Act.
- 25.9** Every person who violates a provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence pursuant to the provisions of the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P. 33, as amended.
- 26.** That By-law Nos. 1702-04-03-89, as amended and 2227-98 are hereby repealed in their entirety.
- 27.** All By-laws inconsistent with this By-law are hereby repealed as of the date of this By-law coming into effect
- 28.** That this By-law shall come into force and effect upon receiving set fine approval from the Regional Senior Justice Ontario Court of Justice.

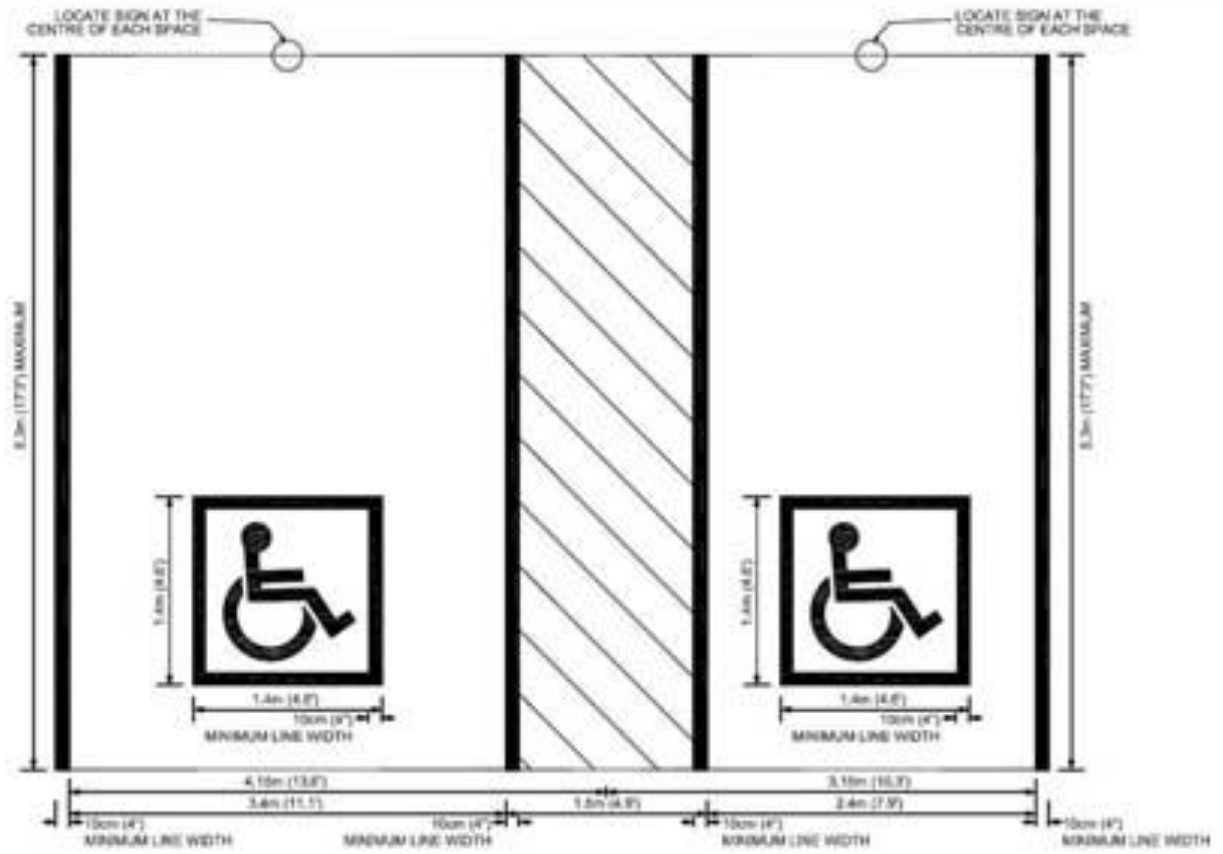


**2. SIGN INSTALLATION**

- a) Where a parking space is designated for use by disabled persons is designated for parallel parking the sign shall be erected adjacent to the parking space within its longitudinal limits. It shall be erected such that it is clear to which parking space the designation applies, but not so as to interfere with access to and from parked vehicles. Signs should be mounted at a height between 1.5 and 2.5 meters, measured from the top of the curb to the bottom of the sign.
- b) Where a parking space is designated for angle parking or parking perpendicular to the roadway, signs designating the parking space for use by disabled persons shall be erected at the front of the parking space, midway between its lateral lines. Signs should be mounted at height of between 1.5 and 2.5 meters, measured from the top of the curb to the bottom of the sign.

### 3. PARKING SPACE MARKINGS

In all cases signs should be augmented, but not replaced by, pavement, markings. Pavement marking shall be the blue reflective background and outline with the white reflective symbol and border as set out below.
