## INTERNET AND TELEPHONE VOTING

The Town of Hanover has selected to use the internet and telephone voting method for the 2022 municipal election. Electors will be able to cast their vote online or by telephone from anywhere they have an internet or telephone connection.

Electors will receive a Voter Information Letter in the mail, providing instructions and a secure Personal Identification Number (PIN) to use to vote by either the internet or telephone.

The Voting Period for this Municipal Election will be Friday, October 14, 2022 at 10:00 am until Monday, October 24, 2022 at 8:00 pm. You can cast your vote 24 hours a day during the voting period.

## HELP CENTRE

A Help Centre will be located at the Municipal Office, 341 10th Street, throughout the **Voting Period (October 14 - 24)** during regular office hours (Monday to Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm). Electors can be added to the Voters' List and receive assistance and clarification on the election process, including access to the internet.
